III. DETAILED COURSE INFORMATION

Teaching Language: Hrvatski

Course Description	U okviru kolegija studenti će razvijati kompetencije čitanja, pisanja, slušanja i govorenja na temelju pisanih tekstova u akademske namjene iz područja psihologije. Studenti će također razvijati vokabular te jezične i analitičke vještine potrebne za akademski uspjeh. Tekstovi će se analizirati na različite načine kao što su: detaljno, letimično i selektivno čitanje teksta; prepoznavanje strukture i dijelova teksta; opće i detaljno razumijevanje teksta; traženje informacija u tekstu; traženje značenja u tekstu; razlikovanje osnovne ideje teksta od detalja kojima je potkrijepljena; prepoznavanje, memoriranje i primjena jezičnih pojmova i gramatičkih struktura, itd. Kolegij će također obuhvaćati učenje vještine akademskog pisanja. Studenti će se učiti vještini kritičkog mišljenja i izražavanja vlastitog mišljenja o relevantnim temama.
